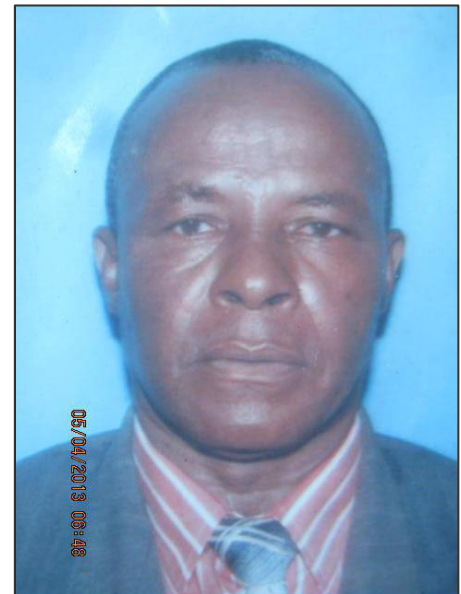




In remembrance . . .

On October 12, 2012, at 8:25 AM, our work train #1002, pulled by locomotive #1004, was subjected to a terrorist attack by activation of an explosive causing the derailment of the engine and flat car with backhoe at Km 45+100 on the The Viper Bridge, damaging the track structure and equipment.

This locomotive was moving a gang of workers who were to remove debris by a landslide that had caused damage to the rail line at Km 045+075. The bomb explosion unfortunately caused the death of our colleague, SEGUNDO ALFONSO VALVERDE, 58 years old and a member of the TRIANA track maintenance crew and a native of the region. We commemorate the regrettable death of our colleague.



Mr. Valverde's death was a difficult blow to the Ferrocarril del Pacifico (FDP) railroad family, but at the same time a greater challenge to recover immediately to show our customers, employees and everyone that we are much stronger as a nation than those who commit terrorist acts to deter us with cowardly attacks that kill innocent civilians and damage the welfare of the people.



October 13-15, 2012 the FDP work crews carried out the preliminary work to ensure the opening of the main line at Km 40+050 and the stability of the affected structure. At the present time, normal rail transport service is operating safely, reliably and trustworthy because it is our promise of courage, without being held by terrorist attacks.
